# Assembly for Sale! How do we recruit?

Most of us have gone thru the agony and ecstasy of the sale of a house. Recruitment is not much different. You may sell the house yourself or you can go to the professionals. Recruitment follows the same logic. Personally, if you are having a challenge getting the right number of candidates, I would ask the professionals for help, get their guidance. This does not mean you are going to Madison Avenue and getting a Marketing team!

What is the first thing you do when selling a house? Who do you get? Obviously a realtor might not be the fit you need to get new candidates. In this case, another Assembly, the State Deputy, or the Master, or your Friar might be the team you need. You can be assured the very first thing you will do is Paint, just as you did when you sold a house. In this case, painting will mean to bring everything you do to the table for a fresh review. Your team will review your program of work or committees or activities to determine which really sell the Assembly. You may have programs that are in place and serve an emotional tie, but are dated programs that have been part of the Assembly since you began. Your review team may give suggestions to modernize and update the programs. Your review team will look at each room in the Assembly. The rooms might be the setup of the meetings, another room might be elections, another room might be socials, another room might be location of the meetings or time of the meetings, another room to look at might be dues and benefits, many rooms to review. So the painting has begun, and it takes time and when the new look is there- WOW, how great you look.

All we have done is the beginning walk-through. The review team begins with updates and upgrades inside and out. Yes, outside upgrades! What is the perception of your Assembly in the community and with the neighbors? What story does the trash can tell? What story does the mailbox tell?

A review of your house looks for modernization hand related improvements to your house, and the same is true for the Assembly. The review team would notice cable TV or WiFi in your house, modern equipment and Upgrades. In the Assembly, the team might ask about LINKS, contacting your members, Websites for the Assembly, Newsletters, and involvement with the Councils supporting the Assembly, and most importantly, the link with the Parishes and Pastors.

Selling a house can be painful, you have lived in it, you thought it was great but a review can find pitfalls that have been there for years and need FIXIN. The Assembly is much the same. New Candidates need to see LINKS. They need to see correlation with the Mission and Goals of the Knights. They need to see there is a place for them in an ever changing world. The New Candidate needs to see the Assembly as a viable organization that will continue their growth and wellbeing. It must be a place that is accessible for their needs as homes must be accessible in the modern sense.

WOW. And we have not even gotten to listing the house on the market. After the realtor team does their walk thru, they do a market comparison and then they tell you the news. Your House is going to bring X amount of dollars. The Assembly picture is not that much different. Instead of dollars you are going to listen to viability and reaching the market and the number of recruits or candidates you may expect. They are your Dollars! You get the news that you are okay and the market is slim, or you get the news you must invest in the Assembly and make changes. Changes might be costly in your eyes just as the homeowner must decide how much to invest and in what. Homeowners might create a package for the buyer, the Assembly team might do the same in the name of change. The New Candidate might be your Web go to person, the new recruit might be the Editor of the Newsletter, a new recruit might handle email list or new committee work. Now that was not so painful!

The Team puts your Assembly on the Market. Your job is not over it is just beginning, you must insure that the changes stay in place. You must begin the process of selling what you say you have. You cannot be guilty of a Bait and Switch! There are new ideas abound!

Selling each room in the house must continue. You must, the Assembly must, display, brag about the great points of each room. Each room is another activity of the Assembly. When was the last time you wrote an article in the newspaper, or out an insert in the Parish Bulletin or had a PSA spot on the radio. Great men are in the Knights and do remarkable work, Showcase their room!

The Assembly must continue the work of the team, the Assembly must take the suggestions create a sense of OWNERSHIP and move forward. You own these changes, you were part of the process. It is the Assemblies promise for a brighter future. So Sell the Assembly! Who wants to BUY!


#### **Answers to October Crosswords Puzzle**


"WE COME FROM THE BALTIC SHORE AND PACIFIC ISLES."
